SECTION I: INTRODUCTION

The Islamic Center of Minnesota (ICM) Scholarship Fund was endowed in 1992 with a vision to recognize and reward college students through annual scholarship awards based upon academic achievement, financial need and service to the community.

The Board at the ICM is pleased to announce the availability of <u>10</u> scholarship awards – totaling \$10,000.00 - for the upcoming academic year 2017-2018. These 10 awards are divided into two separate categories. The first category is designated as <u>"ICM Merit</u> <u>Awards"</u>. For this category, scholarships will be awarded based primarily on academic achievement and service to the community. There are 5 scholarship awards in this category The second category is designated as <u>"ICM Financial Need & Merit Awards"</u>. For this category, demonstrated financial need will be the primary judging criterion followed by academic excellence and community service. There are 5 scholarship awards in this category as well.

SECTION II: ELIGIBILITY

The purpose of the ICM Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to outstanding youth in our community in order to encourage the pursuit of higher education. To be considered for the ICM scholarship, an applicant must:

ELIGIBILITY:

Be a <u>full-time</u> student registered for a <u>degree</u> program at an accredited college or university. Students in their senior year of high school, or at any level of college, may apply for the next academic year.

Completely fill out this application form and submit all supporting documents by the officially notified deadline of **May 12th, 2017**.

ELIGIBILITY:
\blacksquare Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0).
Submit at least two letters of recommendation. These letters should
be written by people who are unrelated to the applicant and who have
had the opportunity to assess and observe the candidate's
academic/work performance, community service, leadership
contributions and/or personal character.
Be a Muslim, and a legal resident of the state of Minnesota

The following criteria will be used by the selection committee:

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA & REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:
GPA and Academic Excellence – Must submit an official transcript from
the school/college/university attended showing completed course-work
and grades.
Demonstrated Financial Need – Must submit documents and financial
information in order to establish financial need (for example, a certified
copy of federal tax form 1040 for tax year 2016). Required only for
applicants for the Financial Need + Merit-Based Scholarship Awards.
Community Service - Provide description of services rendered, personal
references and supporting documents, covering a period of up to 2
previous years.
Two Letters of Recommendations – Submit two letters or
recommendation; one from a school teacher/instructor/professor and the
other from an Islamic organization.
Two Personal Essays – Submit two personal essays as outlined in the
application form. The essays may be no longer than 2 pages each.

- Checks will be issued in the name of the educational institution
- Scholarship awards are non-renewable. Candidates, including award recipients from previous year(s), must reapply in order to be considered for a scholarship award.
- The ICM Scholarship Committee will recruit a set of independent judges from the Minnesota Muslim community who will judge each application. The ICM Scholarship Committee will solely be responsible for all matters related to the scholarship award and the scholarship fund.
- The ICM Scholarship Committee's award decision based on the judge's results will be final.
